HIGHWAYS UPDATE

Drain between new churchyard and substation has pushed up and damaged pavement.

Speed/volume traffic survey has been installed and is operational.

Glenleith Farm, Kilcot. 190748. Application for variation of conditions 2 and 3 of planning permission P151696 (conversion of barn to form dwelling). To allow revised drawings, to include rooflights in the main barn and a larger garage. The Parish Council had no objections.
